

Queen of Hearts

Game Rules - Rumford Falls Aerie #1248

OBJECT OF THE GAME: To choose a card # from the game case each week in search for the Queen of Hearts. The cash pot is progressive and grows each week until the Queen has been found. Each week participants fill out the raffle ticket pictured below for \$1 each. Entrants may play as many cards as they wish.

Queen of Hearts ticket format

- No address labels and take care not to disfigure these tickets. Tickets that are intentionally altered to gain unfair advantage for the drawing will be disqualified and withheld from the drawing.
- Only paid up card carrying members allowed to play
- Members are allowed to purchase and deposit tickets for other eligible member.
- After weekly card is drawn, proof of membership has to be obtained before showcase can be opened.
- Only the first name on a ticket will be honored and payment will be made to that person
- Make sure you know what card slots are available; if your ticket is drawn and you have selected a slot already selected, your reward is already gone and as weekly winner the reward is \$0.
- If ticket pulled belongs to non-member, another ticket will be drawn
- Tickets not to leave the club

Pictured below is a layout of the game case. Underneath each number lays a card (52 playing cards plus 2 jokers) face down.

Every Friday Evening ticket sales for the current week will stop at 6:30 pm and at 7:00 pm one ticket is drawn from the entries received for the current week's drawing. The member whose ticket is drawn then chooses a number slot from the game display case, if not present slot # on ticket will be used. The card behind the chosen slot is turned over and displayed for the remainder of the game with the winner collecting the payout for that particular card. If owner of the winning ticket is not present at the drawing, the slot entry on the raffle ticket drawn will be used and if the ticket of owner not present finds the Queen, it only qualifies for 75% of the reward for finding her and the 25% for not being present rolls over into the pot to start the next game. All other cards pay out as shown in the chart below plus if the winner is present they receive an additional \$25. When the Queen of Hearts is turned over, the game is over and the winner collects the reward that has accumulated to that point and a new game begins. After the drawing each week, all tickets will be discarded and ticket sales will begin for the next weeks drawing.

Payouts as follows:

* Queen of Hearts pays 60% total pot, not present 75% of 60% total pot (example, \$1000 pot pays \$600, not present \$450)

For being present for the drawing winning ticket pays an additional \$25 to the payouts below

* Joker pays \$50

* Ace pays \$40

* Face cards pay \$30

* All other cards pay 3X the card #, (example, 5 turned over would yield \$15, 9 would pay \$27)
